Roger was born on May 5, 1947 in Robinson, IL. He was the son of Delbert and Flo V. (Rush) Reynolds. On December 17, 1966 he married Twila Ann Calvert. They were married for 52 years.

On October 2, 1967, Roger signed onto the airwaves as a full-time disc jockey and later as a salesman at WTAY/WTYE Radio in Robinson, IL where he worked for 51 years. He hosted the "Morning Show" and the "Saturday Oldies" show for over 30 years. Roger was famous for his super hero alter ego "Lunchman" who read school lunch menus and battled his nemesis "Weiner Man".

Roger graduated from Hutsonville High School in 1965. Roger ran his own DJ business where he was known for his discos, dances, parties and wedding receptions. He was known by fellow music fans as "Mr. Oldies" and many considered him as the 5th Beatle. Roger also emceed and introduced performers at LTC Foundation Concerts.

He is survived by his wife Twila Reynolds of Robinson, IL; son and daughter-in-law Ryan Patrick and Jennifer Lynn Reynolds of Robinson, IL; four grandchildren Khristian James Reynolds, Kourtney Lynn Reynolds, Emerson Tucker Reynolds and Felix Patrick Reynolds all of Robinson, IL; half-sister Martha "Mart" and Erland Lingafelter of Hutsonville, IL; sister-in-law Barbara Reynolds of Robinson, IL; several nieces and nephews and former daughter-in-law Stephanie Bland Weber.
